Bulletin to All Stakeholders

Filing Guidelines Update

The Automobile Insurance Rate Board (AIRB) is issuing this Bulletin to advise all automobile insurers operating in Alberta of the following changes.

Filing Guidelines and Appendices

Effective July 1, 2018, amendments have been made to the [filing guidelines and appendices](#):

- For Private Passenger Vehicle (PPV) Full Filing Guidelines:
 - Remove the exemption scenarios, the Filing Guidelines have been in place for four years, and several of the exemptions are now listed in the simplified filing guidelines;
 - Reword the CLEAR section requirement; and
 - Remove the requirement for territorial analysis. Insurers do not have to submit such analysis when no change is being proposed.
- For PPV Simplified Filing Guidelines:
 - Revise the filing requirement section to increase clarity on what qualifies for a simplified filing.
- For all Filing Guidelines, PPV and Non PPV:
 - Clarify capping requirements.
 - Revise information requested in Appendix A to request insurers to provide more details on capping.

All insurer filings must be in compliance with the AIRB bulletins/notices and Ministerial Orders applicable at the time.

Required Action:

The AIRB requires that all insurers follow the latest filing guidelines when preparing their filings and submit the latest version of Appendix A to the office for all filings submitted after July 1, 2018.
